
Past Simple : regular and irregular verbs



The simple past tense is used to talk about a **completed action** in a time **before now**. The time of the action can be in the recent past (ex: yesterday) or the distant past (ex: last year, years ago, etc.)





Key words

For the *Simple Past* these are expressions of time in the past :

yesterday
last week
a month ago
in 2010
this morning

Here are some examples:

She had a dance lesson last week.

His parents married in 2004.

I saw my friend yesterday.

You missed the bus this morning


Irregular verbs






For regular verbs, add -ed at the end.

Ex: walk- walked talk - talked play - played





Ex: go - went eat - ate take - took





Simple present	Simple past
bring	brought
have	had
come	came
make	made
meet	met
get	got
see	saw
give	gave
sing	sang
Etc.	



Affirmative sentences

Subject + verb in the simple past + rest of sentence (RS)

Ex: You bought tickets for the concert.



Negative sentences Subject + did not or didn't + infinitive + RS

Ex: You didn't buy tickets for the concert.



Interrogative sentences Did + subject + infinitive **+ RS** E_{λ} : **Did she buy a CD**?




Interrogative sentences with question words

Question word+ Did + subject + infinitive + RS

Ex: When **Did she buy a CD?**

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
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
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


Where do you live? Where did you put the books



How was your day? How do you know what happened

WHEN? time, occasion When is your birthday? When did you get up?

Why are you so sad? Why didn't you call me?

WHAT? specific thing What are you going to wear? WHICH? choice, alternative Which dress fits me better?
